Special prizes awarded in the Blue Ribbon, Costume, and Jack Benny classes

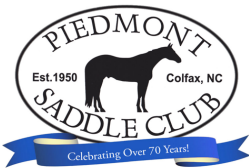
Proof of negative coggins test required—coggins will be checked!
